No one should look to the Association for financial assistance in developing or implementing a drainage plan for their property. A resident desiring to construct water diversion facilities or to alter the landscaping on his or her lot must present a request and receive approval from the Architectural Review Committee before proceeding with the work.

OCTOBER POOL USAGE

At its July meeting, the Board of Directors approved a request to keep our pool open during the month of October. The success of this extended pool season will determine future of such a pool schedule. Since there are no Pool Monitors on duty during September and October, it is important that pool users sign the Visitors Log which will be located in the Cabana. The Log will be used to determine the pool usage during both September and October.
