#### ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

This is accomplished by a Project Request being submitted to the Committee which meets twice a month. Emergency requests will be handled appropriately. #### **ANONYMOUS COMMENTS & COMPLAINTS**

It has always been the policy of the Board to ignore anonymous complaints or comments and that policy remains intact. The Board continues to welcome signed communications from all residents.

#### **CLUBHOUSE LIGHTING**

The old florescent lighting and recessed lighting in the Clubhouse, Pool Cabana and Maintenance Building has been replaced with more energy efficient tubes and ballasts. These changes have made a great difference in the lighting and there will be a saving in our annual electrical costs. The cost of the project was partially funded by a grant through Santee Cooper.

#### BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS

The Ad Hoc Tree Committee has completed its first two projects. The fence around the Lift Station on Myrtle Trace Drive near Cedar Ridge Lane has been painted and the bushes have been replaced by new shrubs. Small trees have been added to the grounds at the Myrtle Ridge entrance.

The Myrtle Trace Nominating Committee chaired by Judy Beam is working diligently to identify well qualified candidates to compete for the two seats on the Board which will be vacated in February. 


