The MTHOA Board of Directors is pleased to wish each of our residents a happy, healthy and safe holiday season.


CLUBHOUSE CLOSURE

Commencing on February 24, 2014, the Clubhouse will be closed to all activities for approximately five weeks for the implementation of the first phases of the Clubhouse Refurbishment Plan. During this period, the flooring and draperies will be replaced, the walls will be painted, sound panels installed and new furniture will be purchased.

2014 BUDGET

The 2014 budget for the MT Homeowners' Association was adopted at the November meeting of the Board of Directors. A copy is enclosed with this newsletter. The budget reflects a combination of carefully managed annual operating expenses and the need to address the current and future needs of an aging community infrastructure.

Under operating expenses, utility and insurance costs along with lake and pool expenses are rising.



In recognition of the aging infrastructure needs, the budget incorporates funding to continue initiatives started during the past year including building additional lake bank retention walls, replacing trees removed from common property, and resurfacing roads as needed. Also included is funding for the initial phases of the Clubhouse Refurbishment Plan. The budget also begins planning for future needs including repairs to the pool area and replacement of lake pumps. This future planning is outlined on the enclosed repairs and replacements schedule.

In order to meet the

current infrastructure improvements and anticipated future projects, the Board approved a dues increase of \$5 per month, raising the member obligation to \$70 per month or \$840 annually.

CLUBHOUSE ALARM SYSTEM

The alarm system in the Clubhouse is set up to be armed daily from 11:00 pm until 6:00 am the next morning. Any movement or activity in the Clubhouse between those hours will alert the police unless the system is manually disarmed. This will result in a phone call to the Clubhouse to confirm that there is not a problem.

AL HARDEE MAINTENANCE

Al Hardee's maintenance staff receives its direction from Al Hardee who, in turn, receives his direction from the Property Committee.

From time to time, a resident may have a question or an issue with the duties performed by the staff. Such concerns should NOT be discussed with the maintenance staff. They should be referred to a Phase Rep. or to the Chairperson of the Property Committee
