HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE

Your Board of Directors is responsible for enforcing the Myrtle Trace Covenants. One provision of those covenants is that each homeowner provide proof of adequate (defined as full replacement cost) homeowner insurance. This requirement is for the protection of the entire community in the event of loss of property. A recent review of the records indicates that some homeowners have not submitted current documentation of coverage. This can easily be done by copying the front page of the policy and dropping it in the HOA mail slot at the Clubhouse or mailing it to MTHOA, 101 Myrtle Trace Drive, Conway, SC 29526. All information is kept confidential and secure.

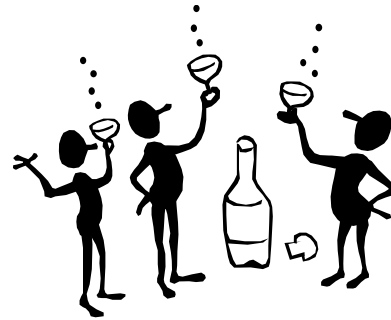
MYRTLE TRACE PLAYERS
