The work involved several steps: grinding down the surface; filling cracks and applying a leveling coat; applying a texture coat; and finally two coats of paint which had a skid resistant additive. The pool will be cleaned; refilled and the mesh cover put on. Stay tuned as the best is yet to come this spring when the final phase of the pool renovation will be done.

Al Hardee's staff has several projects going: painting all mailbox posts; painting all the brown posts which line our streets; building new mailbox posts; and tamping down high spots around mailboxes.

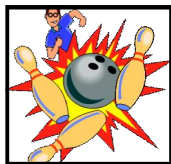

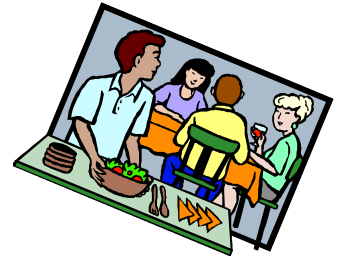
