PROPERTY COMMITTEE

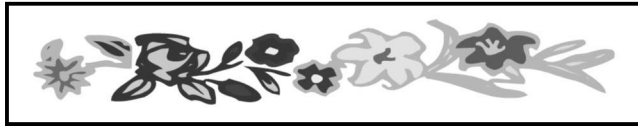
The Clubhouse storage room addition is nearing completion and will be a great help in storing materials and supplies for Myrtle Trace social events. Many thanks to those working on the project.

NOTES FROM THE TREASURER

As of May 31, 2017, our Association continues to do well financially. Our cash balances increased over April's by slightly over \$3,500, while at the same time our Uncollected Accounts Receivables decreased. Our year-to-date income through May was a little over \$1,000 more than budgeted. Daily operating expenses of \$33,861 for May were almost exactly on budget, being only \$48 over budget. Year to date operating expenses were under budget by \$12,750 and our total revenues over expenses year-to-date is \$54,937. Of that amount, \$44,000 will cover our 2016 contribution to our two reserve funds (for roads and designated funds) which we plan to make at the end of September.

We need to stay on budget to meet our goal for an additional \$52,000 for our 2017 contribution to these two funds, which if available will be paid in January, 2018. All in all, our Association is in good shape financially.

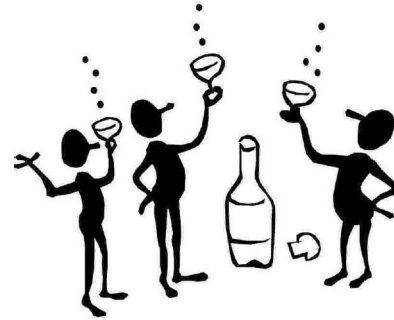

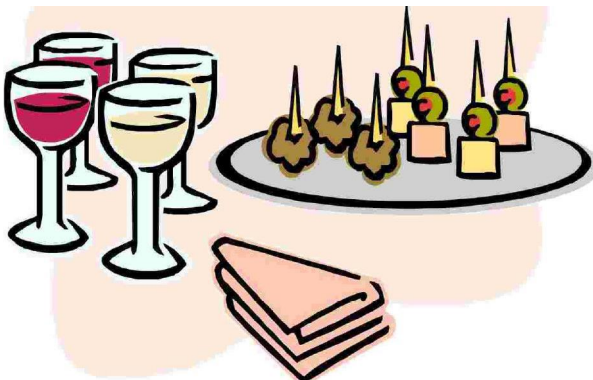

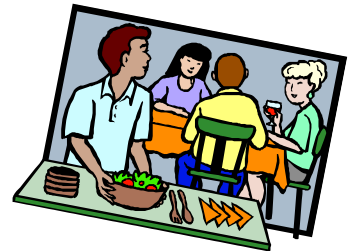
