## BOARD BRIEFS

### SUMMER – SUN, FUN & SAFETY

Summer is here and we will see an increase in population in Myrtle Trace as residents' families, be they children or grandchildren come to visit. In addition to more vehicular traffic on our narrow streets there will be children and adults riding bikes and walking along the side of the road. We always expect our residents to obey the 25 mph speed limit; stop at stop signs and be aware of what is happening around you. But we ask you to PLEASE be especially careful while driving through Myrtle Trace during these summer months. We want all of our summer guests to have a safe and enjoyable time while visiting here. So enjoy your summer, enjoy the sun, have some fun and stay SAFE!!

### LAP SWIMMING IN THE POOL

Sandra Main, the Pool Coordinator, has asked the Board to clarify whether the lifeline rope could or could not be disconnected so people could swim laps. Our current pool policy does not permit the lifeline being disconnected. However, it has come to our attention that according to DHEC Guidelines Regulation 61-51 (June 27, 2014) the lifeline must be "... kept in place except when lap swimming..." This was verified through a discussion with a South Carolina DHEC employee. He said it is permissible to have scheduled lap times. If a representative came to check the pool during scheduled lap time and people were swimming laps the lifeline could be disconnected. However, if the lifeline is disconnected and no one is lap swimming, it is an infraction of the DHEC regulations. Sandra has been asked to form a small committee for the purpose of reviewing the current pool rules with the possible inclusion of times for adult lap swimming. The committee will then recommend the revisions to the Property Committee for approval and ultimately, the Property Committee will make a recommendation for the revised pool policy to the Board for action.

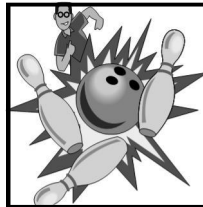
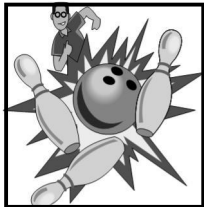
## PROPERTY COMMITTEE

Persons parking near the pool are urged to be aware of the yellow concrete parking blocks and use caution when walking in that area.

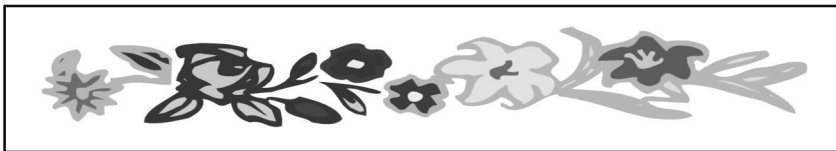

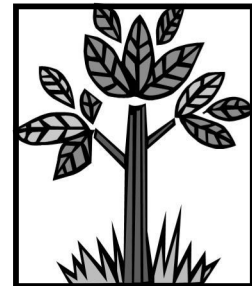

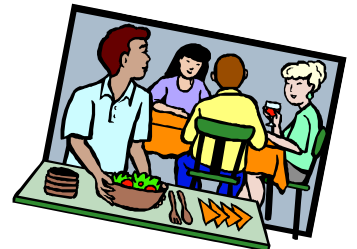
