BOARD BRIEFS

KITCHEN REFURBISHING COMMITTEE REPORT

The Myrtle Trace Clubhouse was built in 1986 and, as many of you know, the main room, library, restrooms and original storage area of the clubhouse underwent a major refurbishing project in 2014. However, due to a number of factors including a hurricane, the kitchen did not get updated as funds were not available. The HOA Board of Directors, in 2018, appointed a Kitchen Refurbishing Committee to develop an updated plan for the kitchen focusing on functionality, safety and appearance. The Committee held many meetings and members have done a great deal of “homework” since then. Bill Fox, committee chair, and Ellen Elliott gave a presentation of the committee’s recommendations including new layout, cost estimates for appliances, cabinets, counter tops, faucets, sinks and lighting. The members of the Board of Directors received a full report which will be reviewed for consideration in the 2019 budget. We thank all the members of the Kitchen Refurbishing Committee: Bill Fox, Chair, Ellen Elliott, Nelson Fisher, Mickey Jarossy, Roger Kirschner, Anne Kongvold and Liz Maass for volunteering their time to complete this project. Your efforts are greatly appreciated.

RECYCLING AT CLUBHOUSE

If you have been to the Clubhouse recently you may have noticed a large blue container for recycling glass, plastic bottles and aluminum cans. This is a result of a resident expressing concern regarding all of the cans and bottles being thrown in the trash during events held in the Clubhouse. We want to do our part to keep recyclable materials out of the landfill. We thank the homeowner for a great suggestion and the Property Committee for purchasing the recycling container.

LAP SWIMMING

Several residents expressed their views and concerns regarding the scheduled lap swimming time provided for Myrtle Trace residents. The time and pool rules, revised at the July board meeting, will remain in effect for this season. However, this issue will be revisited next spring before the pool opens in 2019. We appreciate your cooperation in following and abiding by the pool rules as they are currently written.

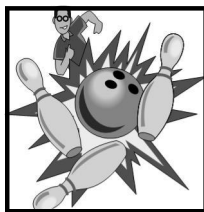
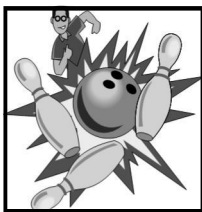

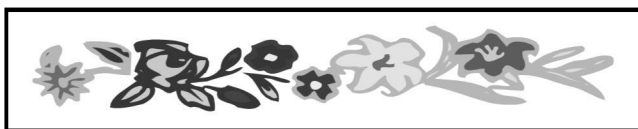
The Committee wishes to thank Roger Kirschner for installing a new hot water heater at the pool.

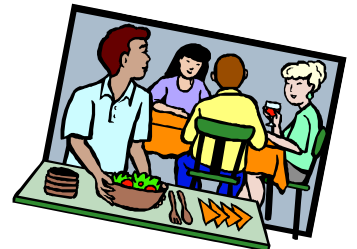
