DOG PARK

Mr. Herman Rebocho withdrew his proposal for a dog park at the January Board meeting. He said the decision was due to the many concerns expressed to him concerning the dog park. He thought it in the best interest of the community to remove the proposal from consideration. The Board accepted his withdrawal of the proposal.

MYRTLE RIDGE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY PURCHASE – UPDATE

The proposed change in the right-of-way would impact the Association in several different ways including: the necessity of having a new well drilled; relocating the piping from the well to Lake Osprey and Lake Dove; and moving irrigation lines. Due to the complexity of the proposal to purchase the right-of-way, and in the best interest of the Myrtle Trace Community, the Board is retaining the services of Doug Zayciek from the Bellamy Law Firm. He is experienced in land condemnation and eminent domain. We will continue to update you as more information becomes available.

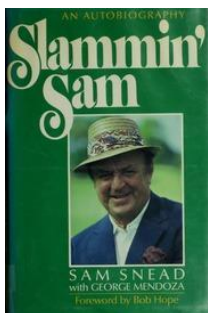
