PROPERTY COMMITTEE

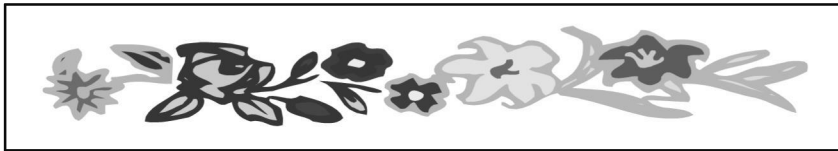
Unfortunately we are still waiting for the road sealing project on Myrtle Trace Drive to be scheduled.

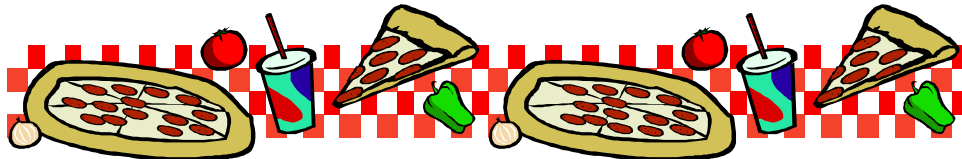

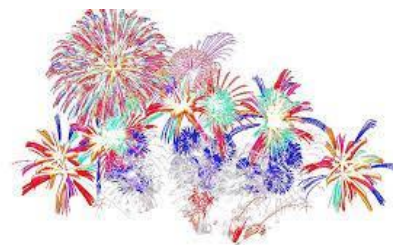
