MYRTLE TRACE DRIVE

Hopefully, with Mother Nature's cooperation, the re-sealing of Myrtle Trace Drive will be completed by the time this issue of the News & Views hits the streets. Rich McEvoy and his Property Committee members have done an outstanding job of coordinating this extremely complex project. The Board deeply appreciates their efforts. Unfortunately, the Board has received reports of a several instances in which drivers have been argumentative with the crew directing traffic and in some cases, abusive. Also, directional signs have been run over and destroyed. The Board is extremely disappointed that this behavior has occurred and asks everyone to please be patient and more considerate.

MYRTLE RIDGE WELL

We have a well located at the end of Cedar Ridge Lane along Myrtle Ridge Road. This well provides water for all of our retention ponds in Phases 6 & 7. Recently, the pump stopped working and we hired a contractor to replace it. Unfortunately, the contractor has been unable to remove the old pump in spite of using 10,000 pounds of pressure. Therefore, we will have to install a new pump in a new well at a significantly higher cost than initially expected.
